No Shows and ALT Process On the day

Officials' programs for the meet will be printed in advance showing the heat & lane allocation of each swimmer for each event and heat. There will be no deletions on the day. When a swimmer fails to show in the marshalling area prior to the start of the race swimmers on the ALT list will be given the opportunity to use the empty lane. An ALT list will be controlled by the marshalling team and an ALT zone will be created for each event. The ALT zone will be three heats before the race and any empty lanes will be given to the ALT swimmer at that point. A list of all ALT events is attached.
